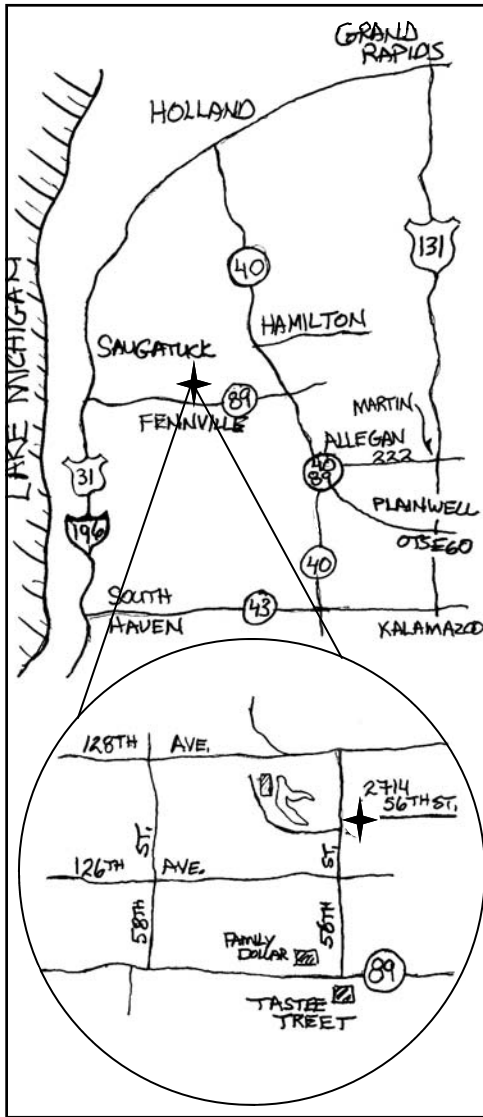

Hunting Safety

- All hunters must present their current Michigan Small Game or Shooting Preserve License. You may purchase your license online at www.mdnr-elicense.com
- All hunters **MUST** wear hunter's orange clothing (hats, vests, coverall, etc.)
- All hunters **MUST** watch safety video and sign "Release of Liability" waiver.
- All dogs must be restrained on a leash or in a mobile kennel when not hunting in the field. They must remain clear of the game bird pen area at all times.
- **No alcohol consumption before or during the hunt.**
- All shooters required to use #5 shot, or smaller. No magnum/hot loads permitted.
- Birds shall not be shot while on the ground.
- Dogs can retrieve any "downed" birds.
- All vehicles must be parked in designated areas.
- Hunters must remain in assigned area and on the property at all times.
- All hunts require a guide, unless waived by management.
- Anybody failing to follow regulations, or who behaves in an unsafe manner, may be requested to leave the property immediately, thus forfeiting payment.
